Emma Brown began singing at an early age in local choirs in her home town of Nottingham. The power of her voice soon established her as a strong soloist. Aged eighteen, she was offered a full scholarship to the Royal Academy of Music in London, but she chose instead to read Music at the University of Cambridge. There, she performed with the Cambridge University Opera Society, the Cambridge University Musical Theatre Society, and as an oratorio soloist with various choirs.

In 2007, Emma moved to The Netherlands to study at the Royal Conservatoire in The Hague. She sang with the New Dutch Opera Academy, Yo! Opera, and at Dutch National Opera. She has sung in choruses at the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam, De Doelen in Rotterdam, and the Anton Philipszaal in The Hague. Currently, she studies with the pianist Han-Louis Meijer.
